

How to Measure Your Kitchen

It doesn't have to be a work of art.....

It doesn't have to be to scale....

Just accurate & legible.

Just follow these easy steps.

- Draw an outline of the walls of your kitchen.
 - Don't worry about the doors, windows & other openings for now.
 - Pick a corner of the kitchen as your "Starting Point" and mark it "Start"
1. Measure each wall from corner to corner.
 2. Draw your doors, openings, & windows. (Remember to measure from outside of the casing to outside of the casing)
 3. Measure from your starting point to the outside of the trim of your first opening. Follow the alphabet in measuring. A,B,C,D, ect.
 4. Now check yourself. The sum of the measurements from B, C, D, ect should equal A. If they don't equal re-measure.
 5. From the corner of the wall measure to the center of your sink. Also with the range/oven, measure from the corner of the wall to the center.
 6. Finally measure your ceiling height and label it "Z" on the center of your drawing. Don't forget to measure any soffits and indicate them in the drawing.
